### FRENCH MARTINI

Vodka, Chambord, Pineapple Juice

*Created in New York in the 1980s, the French Martini became one of the defining cocktails of the modern cocktail renaissance. Named for its use of French Chambord raspberry liqueur, its smooth blend of vodka, raspberry and pineapple has secured its place as a contemporary classic.*

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### MARY PICKFORD

White Rum , Pineapple Juice, Maraschino Liqueur,  
Grenadine

*The one thing that is certain about the story behind the Mary Pickford cocktail is that it got named after a Canadian actress, one of the most famous in Hollywood at this time. The height of her career was during the 1920s, and that was also when the pink cocktail was invented.*

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### SMOKED OLD FASHION

Bourbon Whiskey, Syrup, Angostura Bitters,  
Orange Peel

*This classic drink has been served since the mid-1800s and is as popular today as it was back then. The intent of the old-fashioned is to avoid adding too much to it, which allows the whiskey to shine, although we have added smoke to intensify flavour*

*Originating in Northern Italy, the Aperol Spritz has become one of the world's most popular aperitifs. Created using Aperol, Prosecco and soda water, its bright orange colour and refreshing bittersweet flavour embody the relaxed café culture of the Italian piazza. Light, vibrant and effortlessly elegant, it remains a modern classic.*

## PORNSTAR MARTINI

Vanilla Vodka, Passoa Liqueur, Vanilla Syrup, Passionfruit, Lime Juice, Prosecco

*The cocktail was invented by bartender, Douglas Ankrah, 2002. Originally called 'The Maverick Martini', however, it evolved into the Pornstar Martini, far more catchy and certainly a contributing factor in the cocktail's global fame. When asked about the inspiration behind the Pornstar Martini recipe, the bartender said it was a complete accident.*

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## MARGARITA

Tequila, Triple Sec, Lime Juice

*Believed to have been created in Mexico during the 1930s or 1940s, the Margarita has become one of the world's most iconic cocktails. Combining tequila, orange liqueur and fresh lime juice, its perfect balance of sweet, sour and citrus flavours has made it a timeless favourite for generations of cocktail lovers.*

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## ESPRESSO MARTINI

Vodka, Espresso, Coffee Liqueur, Coffee Beans

*The Espresso Martini is a modern classic cocktail. Created in 1983 by the bartender, Dick Bradsell, who worked at the Soho Brasserie. According to the story, a customer asked for a drink that would wake her up and mess her up!*

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## COSMOPOLITAN

Citrus Vodka, Cointreau, Cranberry Juice, Lime

*Very few cocktails are as instantly recognisable as the Cosmo. Simple yet iconic. There are at least 3 people who claim to have invented the Cosmo. The most popular theory is that it was created by Cheryl Cook, the Martini Queen of South Beach, in the 1980s.*
